Louisiana Professional Engineering

As the end of my term as a LAPELS Board Member and more recently as Board Chairman approaches, I reflect and note many changes in Board operations, Board Rules, and Board responsiveness to Board licensees and applicants.

On many fronts, the changes reflect our changing times. Our Board Staff is much smaller (by almost 50%) than when I first joined the Board. During the same period and more recently we have improved the quality control of the entire registration / licensing process. We have a single software package that keeps up with licensee information, renewals, CPD, and enforcement. Change is the constant in our equation.

Change is, more often than not, good. But change is something we must deal with. The challenge is to approach change with an opportunity to get better than we have been. Our Board Staff is constantly working to be better than we have been. This past year has provided me with an opportunity to see more of the "nuts and bolts" of our operation and witness how we operate. I am proud of our operation. I would invite you to come by the office and see for yourself.

Speaking of change.

Please take a minute (actually several) to review the recent changes to our Board Rules (Title 46, Part LXI) that deal with what you do every day. The changes are posted on our website at www.lapels.com.

There is a change that deals with professional identification by firms involving the use of letterhead, business cards, advertisements and other media to solicit business. Specifically, such items

are no longer required to contain the name of the firm's supervising professional and/or the firm's license number. They are, however, required to contain the exact firm name as it appears on the certificate of licensure issued by the Board.

There are also a number of clarifications and changes to the rules that deal with the use of seals. *The rules were clarified to make it clear that any use of a licensee's seal must be accompanied by the licensee's signature and the date.*

Additionally, the rules were changed to allow the use of seals on certifications of compliance with applicable state and local building code requirements for single family residential design plans, as long as the sealing includes a specific statement contained in the rules.

We have had several disciplinary actions regarding the improper use of seals with preliminary work. Please pay close attention to what the rules require when using "preliminary" drawings for any purpose. And, in general, we have had numerous disciplinary actions in the recent past due to either carelessness or negligence in the use of seals. Clearly, these can be prevented with due care on our part.

As I mentioned earlier in this article, change is a part of our culture, our profession and, indeed, our daily life. This is my last Journal article as Board Chairman. C.L. Jack Stelly, P.L.S., our current Vice Chairman, will become the new LAPELS Board Chairman. Jack brings many years of experience to the Board as a professional land surveyor from Lafayette. Tim Allen, P.L.S., our current Treasurer will become Board Vice Chairman. Tim is a professional land surveyor from

Houma. Jim Garber, Ph.D., P.E. from Lafayette, will become Board Treasurer, and Mark Jusselin, P.E. from Shreveport will become Board Secretary.

LAPELS LA PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING AND LAND SURVEYING BOARD

FROM THE EXECUTIVE SECRETARY

Our staff has been busy receiving and processing applications for the upcoming exam administration. Here are a few details related to applying and taking the exams:

- The spring exam administration is early this year; exams will be administered on April 11 and 12.
- **The Baton Rouge site has changed for this cycle. Exams will be administered at the Lamar Dixon Expo Center (Trademart Building) in Gonzales.**
- We are working with ELSSES (Engineering and Land Surveying Examination Services, the NCEES exam contractor) to provide an exam site in the future at McNeese University.
- The board closely monitors those applicants who have taken the exam multiple times. For individuals who have failed the exam four or more times, the board requires applicants come to the board office and be interviewed by a committee of the board.
- **Applicants wanting to reschedule an exam, with an application on file with our office which is three or more years old, must resubmit a new application including personal references and work verification.**
- In visiting with various groups around the state, I am often asked whether the information included in the application is actually reviewed and I can answer most definitely, yes it is! Once a completed application is received in our office it is then given to a committee of the board to review and I can assure you it is closely scrutinized. Board members read the work experience descriptions, verify whether the work experience is truly verified by a PE, even going so far as to check our website database or the websites in other states. Personal references are read and transcripts analyzed for coursework taken and grades received. All of this information is taken into consideration in making the decision to approve or disapprove an application.
- We are scheduling campus visits to encourage students to take the Fundamentals of Engineering examination. The board recently purchased new FE review manuals to distribute to students preparing for the exam and we hope to have members of local LES chapters join us at the various campuses.

At our January board meeting, several of the Deans from engineering schools from around the state attended and had a

good discussion with our board members. Some of the topics discussed included: on-line educational programs, computer based testing, bachelors + 30 requirements, utilizing the FE exam as an outcome assessment tool and FE/PE review course offerings. Our board enjoys the continued dialogue with the Deans; as both groups learn much from the other.

We have also recently entered into a memorandum or understanding with the Department of Social Services (DSS), agreeing to share the licensure status of all of our registrants, whether active, inactive, retired, expired or suspended. DSS will contact our office in the event a registrant is found in non-compliance with an order of support with DSS and direct the LAPELS board to suspend the license of our registrant until such time the registrant is issued a compliance release from DSS.

Renewal notices have been sent for those of you with licenses good through March 31, 2008. Many of you are taking advantage of our on line renewal option; a win-win solution for all of us.

DISCIPLINARY AND ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS

The Board continues to investigate alleged violations of statutes and rules which regulate the professional practice of engineering and land surveying in Louisiana. Substantiated violations result in disciplinary or enforcement action being taken either through Consent Orders or by Board Orders following a formal hearing at which the respondent is adjudged guilty of one or more violations. Below are summaries of some of the disciplinary/enforcement actions taken by the Board since the last issue of the Journal.

UNLICENSED OFFER AND/OR PRACTICE OF ENGINEERING AND/OR LAND SURVEYING

Eagle Consulting, L.L.C., an unlicensed firm, was subject to enforcement action by the Board for the practice and/or offering of engineering and the use of the word “engineer”, “engineering” or any modification or derivative thereof in a person’s form of business or activity in the State of Louisiana without proper licensure in violation of La. R.S. 37:681 and 37:700(A)(1) and (7). In 2007 the firm issued to clients in Louisiana a rate schedule sheet which listed its consultants as including “Project Engineer” and “Engineering Assistant”. The firm has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein it admitted to a violation of the above statutes and agreed to pay a fine of \$1,000, to pay administrative costs of \$162.53, to immediately cease and desist the offer and/or practice of engineering and the use of the words “engineer”, “engineering” or any modification or derivative thereof in its rate schedule sheets or other solicitations or activities in Louisiana until it is duly licensed by the Board, and to the printing of a summary of this matter by name in this publication.

Pacheco Koch Consulting Engineers, Inc., a Louisiana licensed engineering firm which was not licensed as a land surveying firm, was subject to enforcement action by the Board for the unlicensed practice of land surveying in Louisiana in violation of La. R.S. 37:681 and 37:700(A)(1). In 2006 the firm’s employee (James A. Koch, Jr., P.E.), on behalf of and in the name of the firm, signed and sealed (with his Louisiana professional engineer’s seal) a survey plat for a sanitary sewer servitude in Louisiana. The firm has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein it admitted to a violation of the above statutes and agreed to pay a fine of \$2,500, to pay administrative costs of \$140.78, to immediately cease and desist the offer and/or practice of land surveying in Louisiana until it is duly licensed by the Board, and to the printing of a summary of this matter by name in this publication.

James A. Koch, P.E., a Louisiana licensed engineer who was not licensed as a professional land surveyor, was subject to disciplinary and enforcement action by the Board for (a) the unlicensed practice of land surveying in Louisiana in violation of La. R.S. 37:681 and 37:700(A)(1) and (b) the aiding or assisting another person in violating the laws and/or rules of the Board in violation of La. R.S. 37:698(A)(12). In 2006 Mr. Koch, on behalf of and in the name of his employer (Pacheco Koch Consulting Engineers, Inc.), signed and sealed (with his Louisiana professional engineer’s seal) a survey plat for a sanitary sewer servitude in Louisiana. Mr. Koch has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein he admitted to a violation of the above statutes and agreed to pay a fine of \$1,000, to pay administrative costs of \$140.78, to immediately cease and desist the offer and/or practice of land surveying in Louisiana until he is duly licensed by the Board, to successfully complete the Board’s online Louisiana Laws and Rules Examination, and to the printing of a summary of this matter by name in this publication.

Structural Solutions, L.L.C. Foundation Services, an unlicensed firm, was subject to enforcement action by the Board for the practice and/or offering of engineering and the use of the word “engineer” in the description of a firm’s business or activity in Louisiana without proper licensure in violation of La. R.S. 37:681 and 37:700(A)(1), (7) and (9), to wit LAC Title 46:LXI§2301(B)(1). In 2005 the firm maintained an office in Louisiana, published newspaper advertisements and issued business cards to persons in Louisiana which described the firm as “engineers”. In 2006 a Louisiana licensed engineer (on behalf of and in the name of the firm) prepared and submitted to a Louisiana city permit office a sealed and signed piling plan for property located in Louisiana. The piling plan also described the firm as “engineers”. The firm has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein it admitted to violations of the above statutes and rule and agreed to pay a fine of \$2,500, to pay administrative costs of \$617.88, to immediately cease and desist the offer and/or practice of engineering and the use of the word “engineer” or any modification or derivative thereof in describing its business or activities in Louisiana until it is duly licensed by the Board, and to the printing of a summary of this matter by name in this publication.

Kristin E. Rosendale, an unlicensed individual, was subject to enforcement action by the Board for the unlicensed offering of engineering and the use of the word “engineer”, “engineering” or any modification or derivative thereof in a person’s name or form of business or activity in the State of Louisiana without proper licensure in violation of La. R.S. 37:681 and 37:700(A)(1) and (7). In 2006 Ms. Rosendale issued written solicitations and/or business cards to persons in Louisiana which described her as a “Biological Engineer”. Ms. Rosendale has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein she admitted to an unintentional violation of the above statutes and agreed to pay a fine of \$500, to pay administrative costs of \$125.89, to immediately cease and desist the offer of engineering and the use of the word “engineer”, “engineering” or any modification or derivative thereof in her title or position or in describing her business or activities in her written solicitations, business cards or other documents in Louisiana until she is duly licensed by the Board, and to the printing of a summary of this matter by name in this publication.

Dabney Engineering, Inc., a non-resident unlicensed firm, was subject to enforcement action by the Board for the unlicensed practice and/or offering of engineering and land surveying and the use of the word “engineering” in a firm’s name in the State of Louisiana without proper licensure in violation of La. R.S. 37:681 and 37:700(A)(1), (7) and (9), to wit LAC Title 46:LXI§2301(B)(1). In 2004 and 2007 the firm’s employee (on behalf of and in the name of the firm) prepared and submitted to clients in Louisiana property boundary survey plats

for property located in Louisiana. The firm has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein it admitted to violations of the above statutes and rule and agreed to pay a fine of \$2,500, to pay administrative costs of \$850.86, to immediately cease and desist the offer and/or practice of engineering and land surveying and the use of the word “engineering” in its firm name in Louisiana until it is duly licensed by the Board, and to the printing of a summary of this matter by name in this publication.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT REQUIREMENTS

Jonathan T. Gibson, P.E., a Louisiana licensee, was subject to disciplinary action by the Board for failing to comply with the continuing professional development (CPD) requirements of the Board in violation of La. R.S. 37:698(A)(6), to wit LAC Title 46:LXI§3117 and 3119. In 2006-07 Mr. Gibson failed to submit proof of CPD compliance in response to a Board audit and then failed to submit such proof within 120 days after notice of noncompliance from the Board. Mr. Gibson has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein he admitted to violations of the above statute and rules and agreed to pay a fine of \$250, to pay administrative costs of \$192.42, to pay an administrative fee of \$200, to successfully complete the Board’s online Louisiana Laws and Rules Examination, to submit an up-to-date, complete Professional Development Activity Log and all supporting documentation for the renewal period in question, and to the printing of a summary of this matter by name in this publication.
